
FABRIC CARE & CLEANING CODES

Cleaning Codes

Upholstery fabrics are classified into one of the following four categories. Our fabric list and all fabric samples are marked with the following codes. These cleaning methods are suggested by the fabric manufacturers. Gabby[®] does not accept any responsibility in the event of a failure of any of these methods.



Clean only with water-based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Do not over wet. Do not use solvents to spot clean. Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance. Cushion covers should NOT be removed for laundering.



Clean only with a dry-cleaning solvent. Do not saturate. Do not use water. Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance. Cushion covers should NOT be removed and dry-cleaned.



Clean with shampoo or dry-cleaning solvents as desired. Do not saturate with liquid. Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance. Cushion covers should NOT be removed and dry-cleaned.

Caution: Never remove cushion covers for separate dry-cleaning or washing, even though they do have zipper. Do not use bleach or any tumble method cleaning service as this may destroy the backing of the fabric or shrink or otherwise damage the upholstery fabric.

Consumer Alert: Keep your furniture and family safe from fires caused by careless smoking. Do not smoke when drowsy. Immediately remove any glowing embers or lighted cigarettes that may have fallen on the furniture. **SMOLDERING SMOKING MATERIAL CAN CAUSE UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE FIRES.**
